Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

- The Buyer Planner is responsible for the day-to-day management of suppliers, contract manufacturers, suppliers of packaging and components as well as for planning purchasing requirements for new and existing and products.
- Coordinates all buying and planning for all suppliers and production work order schedules to meet all MRP demands and Sales Orders.

• Plans, prepares, issues, and controls production schedules and material requirements to ensure a controlled flow of approved materials timed to meet production requirements

• Analyzes inventory usage and identifies potential problems and causes that effect inventory level objectives

· Sets up and adjusts Kanban/JIT systems to meet business needs

• Recommends changes to improve product or process efficiency and/or reduce cost using continuous improvement principles

- Interprets MRP and makes decisions on stocking and replenishment
- Prepares RFQs and purchase orders

- Certification including, but not limited to: APICS, Certified Production and Inventory Management (CPIM) or Certified Supply Chain Professional (CSCP) is preferred.
- 3+ years' experience managing personnel.
- In-depth knowledge of computerized manufacturing systems and concepts (MRP / Shop Floor Control); pcMRP preferred.
- Strong computer skills and knowledge of computer software (Windows, Word, Excel, Outlook).
- Demonstrated knowledge of business and management principles involved in resource allocation, leadership technique, production methods, and cost management.
- Strong communications skills both verbal and written.
- Strong analytical and problem solving skills.
- Must be able to juggle multiple tasks simultaneously and be able to prioritize tasks by levels of importance and urgency.
